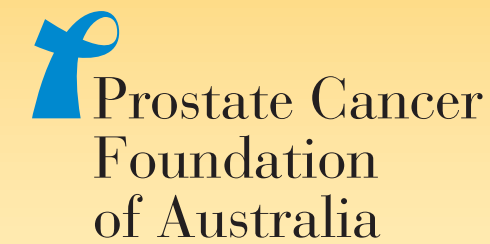

	Berry Street helps children, young people and families across Victoria recover from the devastating effects of violence, abuse and neglect by providing safe homes, foster care, schooling, trauma support and counselling. \$185 pays for a carer to receive vital coaching to equip them in supporting a highly traumatised child in their care
	CircusOz provides members of the community that are marginalised either financially or socially with access to circus performances and workshops. \$100 pays for 5 students from disadvantaged schools to attend a circus performance and skills workshop
	The Daniel Morcombe Foundation helps young victims of crime through counselling services and financial support, and assists educators and parents in educating children about their personal safety. \$100 pays for 5 schools to receive a "Keeping Kids Safe" Resource Kit
	EdConnect helps disadvantaged primary school students get the academic, social and emotional help they need at school by connecting them with volunteers who provide one-on-one mentoring and classroom support. \$112 pays for a student to receive one-on-one mentoring support for a term
	The Good Foundation runs the Ministry of Food program, teaching at-risk Australians how to cook for themselves. It equips them with the simple skills and food knowledge they need to live healthier, happier lives. \$140 pays for a child (12 years+) to participate in a 4 day school holiday program to learn how to cook
	HeartKids provides support for the entire life journey of those affected by childhood heart disease and funds life-saving research into the treatment, management and prevention of childhood heart disease. \$135 pays for a child to be able to monitor their heart condition medication for a year
	KickStart for Kids provides breakfast and lunch, as well as mentoring programs, to disadvantaged primary school children in South Australia. \$100 pays for a child to receive breakfast every day for a school term
	McGrath Foundation supports women and men experiencing breast cancer by providing them with access to a dedicated breast care nurse, no matter where they live, free of charge. \$147 pays for a patient undergoing chemo to be supported by a breast care nurse
	Orange Sky Laundry provides homeless people across Australia with dignity, and positive and genuine conversation through a free mobile laundry service. \$120 pays for 20 cycles of washing and 20 hours of conversation
	The Perth Children's Hospital Foundation helps more than 55,000 children and their families each year who visit the hospital by funding clinicians, equipment, research programs and early intervention programs. \$100 pays for 4 patients to attend a fun incursion such as a mad scientist workshop or pottery playroom class
	The Prostate Cancer Foundation of Australia helps support men and their families affected by prostate cancer by providing them with vital resources, support groups and prostate cancer specialist nurses. \$150 pays for a patient affected by prostate cancer to be supported by a prostate cancer nurse
	The RSPCA works to prevent cruelty to animals by actively promoting their care and protection. Each year the RSPCA looks after more than 130,000 animals through their animal shelters and adoption centres. \$255 pays for a dog or cat to get ready to be adopted
	Soldier On helps veterans navigate the process of reintegrating into the community by providing mental health support and treatment, employment support, social connections and programs. \$120 pays for 2 veterans to receive one-on-one support from a Reintegration Officer
	Whitelion helps highly vulnerable at-risk young people, aged 12-25 years, through specialist youth outreach services including case management, housing, mentoring, education and employment programs. \$120 pays for outreach to 4 at-risk youths and provides them with a warm meal, clothing and hygiene products
