Eligibility

Any organisation (employer, charity, supplier or other) that has crafted and delivered a workplace giving innovation. Also charities which launched or refreshed a WPG program in the last 12 months are eligible to apply for this award.

Judging

The independent judging panel has a wealth of workplace giving experience including specialist knowledge in programs and community outcomes.
