

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Nominations must be received by the Awards Secretariat (Workplace Giving Australia (WGA)/Good2Give (G2G)) by 26 August 2022, 5pm Australian Eastern Standard Time.

Nominations **must** be submitted via the online application forms on www.1MDonors.org.au.

Applications must receive sign-off from key stakeholders within the nominated organisation. It is strongly recommended that in instances where a partner or supporting organisation is mentioned within an application, that they also approve the entry.

There is **no limit to the number of categories** applicants may enter, provided they meet the eligibility criteria for each category.

Organisations **may only submit one entry per category, with the exception of “Most Innovative Charity / Employer Partnership” and “Best Innovation”** where there is no limit to the number of entries.

All information and data relating to applications must be based on the time frames specified for each category, a summary of which is below:

12-months prior to submission

- Best Overall Program Small/Medium (up to 999 employees)
- Best Overall Program Large (1000 or more employees)
- Best Pro-Bono / Workplace Volunteering
- Most Innovative Charity / Employer Partnership**
- Best Innovation
- Best Employer Grants Program

18-month prior to submission

- Best Launch / Refresh (Employer)

Organisations may only submit one launch / refresh campaign into the “Best Launch / Refresh Award” (Employer).

Public Ancillary Funds (PAFs)

In instances where a PAF is the vehicle for managing the company's community investment, and only receives charitable donations from that one company and/or its employees, for the purposes of these Awards, it will be considered to be a part of that company and should enter Awards open to 'Employers'. In instances where the PAF accepts donations from more than one employer organisation, for the purposes of these Awards it will be considered to be an independent entity and should enter the Awards open to 'Charities'.

Shortlisted finalists may be required to produce further proof or details to support their application(s).

Judges reserve the right to determine whether an entry qualifies as acceptable. Entries the judges deem unacceptable will be ruled invalid. Judges may deem an entry invalid if, in the past year, the entering organisation has faced any community backlash over its operating practices.

****For the purposes of these Awards, any employer cause-related marketing or community fundraising activity must be related to the employer's workplace giving program, with the workplace giving program being the primary component of the activity.**

All judges' decisions are final and no correspondence will be entered into relating to the judging process or the outcome.

These conditions may be amended at the discretion of WGA/G2G.
